



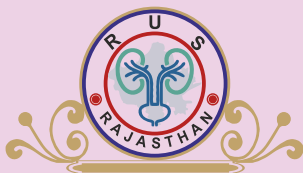

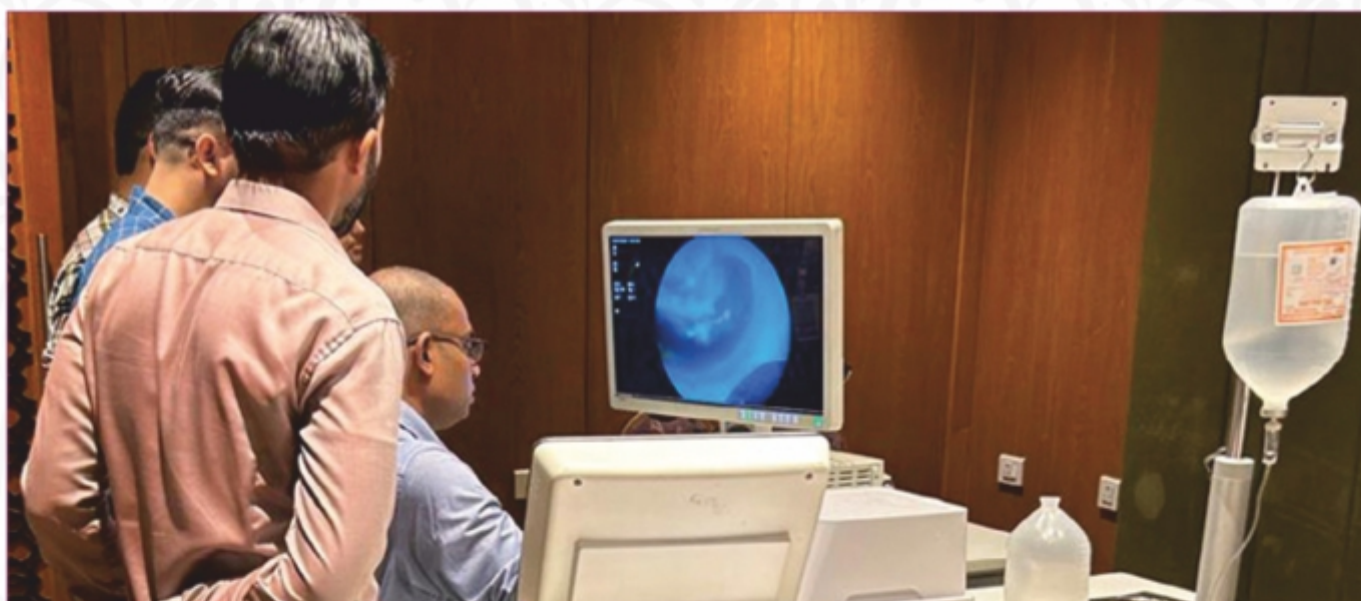

LASERS AND MISTS IN LUTS/BPH **SPONSORSHIP ₹ 3 Lakh**

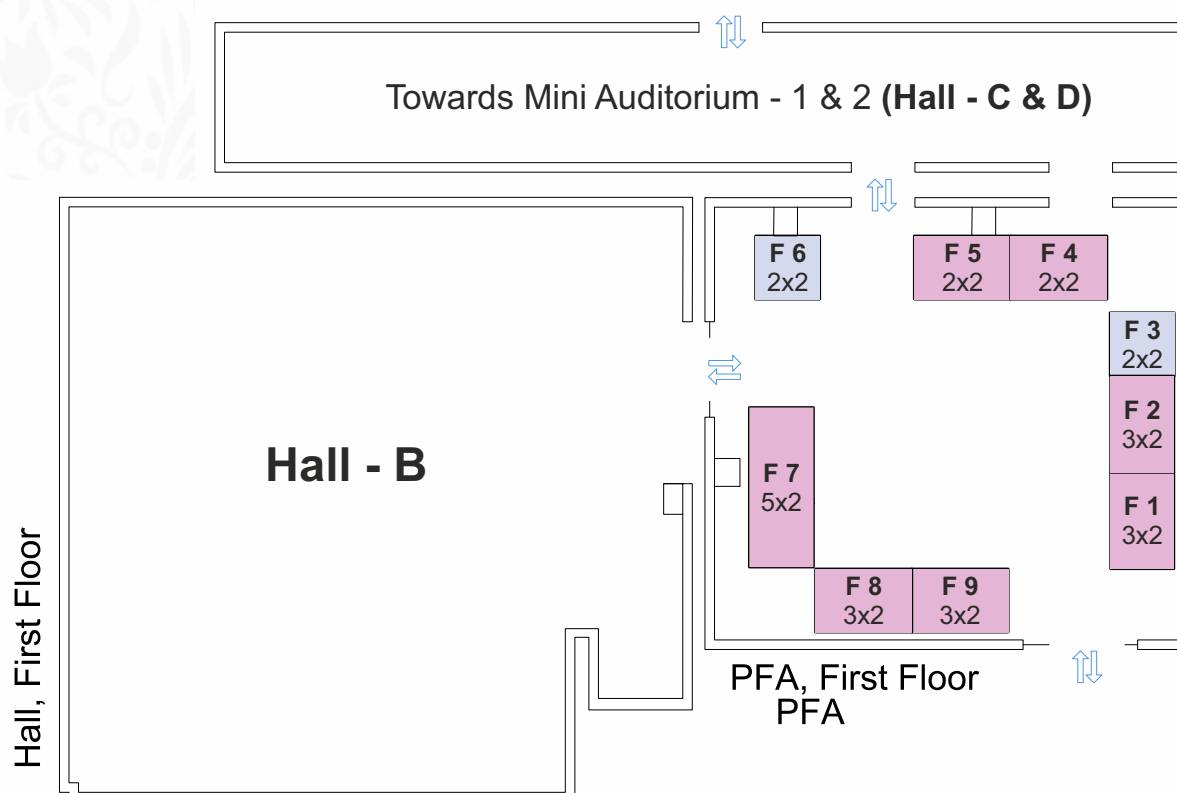
MULTIPURPOSE HALL : GROUND FLOOR
